

The Audit Committee (John Ventura and John Buxton) was appointed at the regular Board meeting on 3/5/14. On 3/28/14, the committee met with Treasurer Renee Stoll to examine the source documents and to examine the appropriate receipts. She provided the committee with a copy of the checking and savings account balances as of 3/27/14, a copy of the updated Operating Budget and a reproduction of the checkbook ledger. These documents will be attached to the approved copy of this report. Receipts were in a notebook referenced to checks.

The 3/27/14 bank statement showed a checking account balance of \$1,817.49 and a savings account balance of \$1,075.92. The checkbook ledger shows a balance of \$1,767.49 with Checks # 809 and #811 outstanding in the total amount of \$50.00 Adding the outstanding checks back to the check ledger yields \$1,817.49 The Treasurer has followed up on the two outstanding checks. The savings account is in complete agreement between Treasurer Records and bank statement.

Based on this examination, the Audit Committee concurs with the Treasurer that the MJEC has a combined bank balance of \$2,843.41 as of 3/27/14. At the beginning of the year, the combined balance was \$2,584.30, a \$259.11 increase in assets.

Budgeted and actual incomes were \$2,000.00 and \$2,300.00, respectively. Budgeted and actual expenses were \$2,765 and \$2,040.89, also respectively. Actual expenses were less than budgeted by \$724.11. Participation in the Student Contest was good but due to the necessary re-scheduling caused by snow, the MJEC did not have the expense of Student Contest winners and families attending the Engineers Week Banquet.

The Audit Committee recommends that this report be submitted to the representatives electronically, that the approved report be attached to the April minutes and that Treasurer Renee Stoll be commended, yet again, for her work.
